RULES: WKF rules with two third places.

For youth categories adjusted WKF rules:

- For U14, U12 the duration of kumite bout is 1,5 min and the maximum points difference is 6.
- For U10 the duration of kumite bout is 1 min and the maximum points difference is 4.
- U10 kata can be repeated in next round.
- U12 kata can be repeated from the third round, except the last kata.
- U14 kata can be repeated from the fourth round, except the last kata.

REGISTRATION FEE: for seniors, juniors, cadets, youth 30 € per individual discipline, 40 € per team, cash payment at registration. Late registration 50 € per each individual discipline.

PRIZES: Diplomas and medals in individual categories, trophies for the first three places in all categories. Awarding ceremonies will be held during the competition.

REFEREES: Qualified referees from other countries are welcome.

PROTECTING EQUIPMENT: WKF RULES.

INSURANCE: All competitors enter this competition at their own risk and must have a valid personal insurance licence.
